- The school principal is asking if there is a possibility for the band to do both the game and BHS comp on 10/7, he was informed it would depend on our performance time given.
- With competition season starting we will need volunteers to help push props and equipment, virtual sign ups will be sent out soon.
- We will also be needing snacks and water donations and will be sending out an email for that as well.

Other:

- We are planning on having a practice loading day to figure out how to transport our props, especially the stars, we might need a 3rd trailer, but we will have more to come.
- Trailer wrap through American Business Machines is a total of \$6,706.26 and if they are approved to be our sole sponsor our cost would be \$2,975.75, small trailer total would be \$3,083.64 and our price would be \$1,406.67 and we are seeking approval; Cain Garcia motions to approve and Melissa Amaya seconded, all ayes – approved. We will submit this to the school to have it reviewed by the district for approval.
